# ABOUT GEORGE FLOYD GLOBAL MEMORIAL

George Floyd Global Memorial (GFGM) is a cultural heritage preservation organization that exists to conserve stories of resistance to racial injustice. GFGM curates spaces for all people to grieve, pay their respects, and be a voice for justice.

Our vision is to enhance collaborative community development in Minneapolis and inspire people to pursue racial justice & equity worldwide.



On May 25th, 2020, George Floyd was murdered at the hands of the Minneapolis Police Department at the intersection of 38th Street E and Chicago Avenue S. The footage of his death sparked global protests, calls for justice, and a need for collective grieving. George's death inspired the world to stand in solidarity for racial justice and spotlighted the pervasive impacts of systemic racism. **We do not intend to let this moment pass us by.** 

At the intersection of 38th Street E and Chicago Avenue S in Minneapolis, MN remains a community of a people who are taking back their power -- the power our governing systems have historically tried to take away. This location serves as a place of healing, grieving, reflecting, empowerment, and planning. This location is what we call George Floyd Square.

The George Floyd Global Memorial was established to bring together members of George Floyd's family, the local community, and the world to demand and pursue justice. Our work ensures that the stories of the community are told within their original narratives, and used as educational resources for generations to come. The George Floyd Global Memorial is and will continue to be a living memorial that inspires all people to pursue justice.

# **ABOUT RISE & REMEMBER**

## **UBUNTU: MAKE THE IMPOSSIBLE, POSSIBLE**

Our theme for *Rise* & *Remember* this year is *Ubuntu*: *Make the Impossible*, *Possible*. Ubuntu is a South African word and philosophy translated as, "I am, because we are." It derives from the Xhosa (Kōs-uh) language and acknowledges the relationship between self and humanity. Ubuntu directly challenges western ideals of individualism with ideals of collectivism. Essentially, it values people over profit, community over individualism, and collective power over individual power. When we see how our humanity is inextricably bound up in the humanity of others, we will be moved to guarantee liberation and justice for all.

#### **EVENT FUNDRAISING GOAL**

To fully achieve our vision and ensure that *Rise* & *Remember: Ubuntu* is a transformational experience of culture, celebration, remembrance, in the ongoing pursuit of racial justice; **our goal is to raise \$400,000.** The participation of companies like yours, through *Rise* & *Remember* sponsorships, is a crucial part of our collective work towards justice, and a way to engage your company's value of racial equity. # **EVENT GOALS AND OBJECTIVES**

In order to remember those who have been lost unjustly and to effectively gather people together to rise to the occasion in the pursuit of racial justice, we developed four objectives for *Rise and Remember*.



Increase awareness of the George Floyd Global Memorial nonprofit, plans for a permanent building for the collection of offerings, and highlight the community committed to preserving and protecting the area where George Floyd was murdered by officers of the Minneapolis Police Department on May 25, 2020.



Honor and celebrate the community members who have held the physical space at George Floyd Square through public recognition at the event, social media storytelling, and oral history preservation. Through telling the story of GFS from the hearts and voices of the individuals who've poured their love and care into the protection and preservation of the George Floyd Global Memorial, GFGM maintains a commitment to being the "keepers of the story."



Provide thoughtful and meaningful acknowledgment of families who've lost loved ones to police violence in Minnesota and throughout the United States, as a gesture from the family of George "Perry" Floyd to the families who share their unique pain and interest in justice and lasting social change. Create long-term solidarity for shared support and advocacy to families who are awaiting justice.



Leverage the anniversary event to create lasting connections with stakeholders in the business community and residents living in the vicinity of 38th and Chicago. Additionally, use fundraising efforts to build relationships with corporate foundations in Minnesota and throughout the United States.

To reach these strategies, we broke *Rise & Remember* into four separate events: Candlelight Vigil, Racial Justice Conference, George Floyd Global Memorial Gala, and Festival.



George's death spotlighted the real and disparate impacts of police brutality on marginalized communities as well as inspired the world to demand justice for these victims. To this day, George's family and the community continue to grieve and fight for racial equity.

These candlelight vigils serve as sacred moments of remembrance. Through the focal point of George's death we know there is a collective hope; hope for a world that sees us, hears us, and rallies alongside us. At these candlelight vigils, we WILL reflect, we WILL center our hope, and we WILL find solace in our community.

In 2021, we lit over 600 LED candles, which allowed hundreds of people to participate in a collective act of remembrance.
